I have today, Saturday, March 5th 1994, participated in collecting groundwater samples. Those samples are tapped on 16 glass and plastic bottles, intended to undergo chemical research in Germany.

The water sample is derived from the exploration borehole, named VA - 2, in the township of Hafnarfjörður community. Further information about the locality, hydrogeological setting and the hole itself can be derived from NEA report PHH-FS-94/01 dated February 21st. 1994.

Sampling was performed by aid of an electric-powered pump, yielding approximately 1 l/s. Sampling started after 60 minutes of pumping at 14:00 G.M.T. Water samples were collected in six 2 liters plastic bottles, and ten one liters glass bottles. Sampling was completed at 14:20, total amount of water sampled; 22 liters, temperature of water when sampled; 4.3° C; air temperature; -3.5° C.
